# STATEWIDE ORDERS & UA PROTOCOLS

---

- Gov. Kay Ivey has issued a statewide mask order that goes into effect at 5:00 PM today
- UA has a directive in effect making masks mandatory in all campus buildings

# PROCLAMATION PROTECTING AGAINST COVID-19 LAWSUITS

---

- “[a] business, health care provider, or other covered entity shall not be liable for the death or injury to persons or for damage to property in any way arising from any act or omission related to, or in connection with, COVID-19 transmission or a covered COVID-19 response activity, unless a claimant shows by clear and convincing evidence that the claimant’s alleged death, injury or damage was caused by the business, health care provider, or other covered entity’s wanton, reckless, willful, or intentional misconduct.”

# COVID-19 JOBSITE REQUIREMENTS

---

- Masks are required in **all** UA buildings
- Portolets
  - Sanitize three times per week
  - Evacuate twice per week
  - Document all cleanings and sanitation
- Elevators/vertical transports sanitized daily

# COVID-19 JOBSITE REQUIREMENTS

---

- Motor operated equipment sanitized daily
- Hand tools and other miscellaneous items sanitized after each use if shared, otherwise daily
- Field office sanitized daily
- Mask distribution

# COVID-19 JOBSITE REQUIREMENTS

---

- COVID Inspector/Monitor (Additional Staff Member)
  - Monitors Hand Sanitizer/Washing Station
    - Refill regularly & document
  - Ensures Compliance with PPE/Social Distancing
    - CDC Guidelines
    - State Guidelines
    - UA Guidelines
    - Contractor Guidelines
  - Temperature Check at Project Entrance
    - Mask distribution/check
  - Reports and logs as necessary to verify compliance

# JOBSITE TRANSPORTATION

---

- Bus Services begin July 20<sup>th</sup> and will be funded and managed by UA
  - Expect a mandatory temperature check prior to boarding
  - Masks are required
  - The buses will be cleaned at least twice per day
  - 8 buses will be in operation
  - 12 passengers per bus to follow social distancing guidelines
  - Hand sanitizer will be provided on the buses
  - Run times are 6:00 AM to 8:30 AM and 3:30 PM to 6:00 PM
